MILL OF VALMY
Mill of Valmy 51800 Valmy

The first Mill of Valmy was destroyed at the Battle of Valmy in 1792 following the orders of Kellermann. Rebuilt then destroyed on several occasions, today's mill is the fourth to be drawn up on the site, following its destruction after the 1999 storm (December 26).
